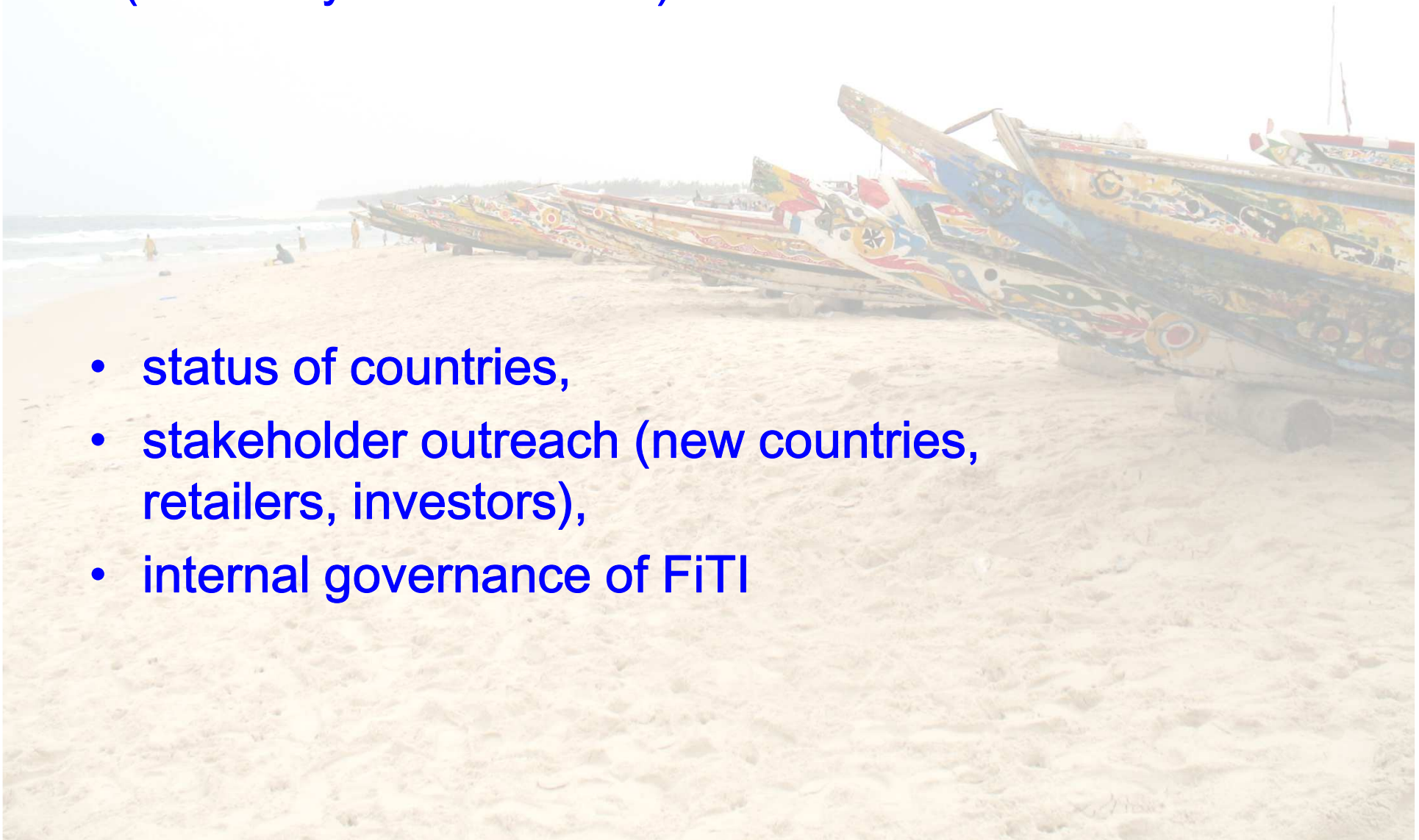

Mauritania, Seychelles, Indonesia in final stages of implementing the six sign-up steps

(e.g. National Lead, National Multi-Stakeholder Group, National Secretariat, 1<sup>st</sup> Work Plan)



## Countries (cont.)

- ✿ Mauretania expected to hand in their candidate application in June/July 2018
- ✿ FiTI Int. Board received an official Letter of Intent from the government of Nigeria to implement FiTI
